Prices and Conditions

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1 General provisions

1.1 Provisions for use of facilities

Along with current statutory regulations, use of facilities shall be governed by the regulations contained in this Statement of Prices and Terms and by the Standard Terms and Conditions of Business of the MSC GATE as of 1 October 2004.

1.2 Orders for use of facilities

Orders must be given for use of facilities; such orders must be given to the company in electronic form.

1.3 Charges

- 1. Gross weights and dimensions shall be used for calculation. Goods over 10 t must be declared separately.
- 2. Minimum charge: **EUR 57,35** unless agreed otherwise.
- 3. The prices specified in this Statement are for packages in seaworthy packaging of a kind customary in the industry and are applicable only if the goods are not subject to special provisions of the GGV-See (ordinance on transport of hazardous substances by seagoing vessels) or other legal provisions.
- 4. For services which are not indicated in this Statement or which require special expenditure, charges must be agreed upon with MSC Gate in advance.
- 5. Charges apply on weekdays Monday to Friday for the first shift. Work outside these hours is possible by arrangement. Extra charges will be levied for work outside these times.
- 6. All charges are net amount in accordance with the VAT Act.
- 7. As a rule, the charges shall be collected in arrears; however, the MSC Gate shall be entitled to require advance payments. For goods in storage passing into other hands, charges up to the date when transfer of ownership takes place shall be paid immediately. MSC Gate's expenses must be reimbursed in cash immediately.
- 8. Invoices shall be payable immediately upon receipt. Incoming payments shall be set off against the oldest accounts receivable. After 14 days interest may be charged amounting to 8 % above the basic interest rate of the European Central Bank.
- 9. All billed services not specified in this Statement of Prices and Conditions shall be charged according to actual cost.
- 10. A social fund of 1.5 % will be charged on all services with the following exclusions:
 - Storage charges
 - Materials for packing and lashing
 - Security charges

1.4 Liability for payment

- 1. The liable payee shall be the client, unless particular exceptions are stated below.
- 2. For the use of quay handling facilities by a seagoing vessel, charges shall be made to the ship's agent.
- 3. Handling charges for goods via quay shall be made to the following:
 - a) For outgoing sea traffic, to the issuer of the port electronic record (BHT), or in other cases to the ordering party
 - b) For incoming sea traffic, to the recipient of the cargo, or in other cases to the earlier client
 - c) For provisions or other ship's supplies as per item 11 to the ship or the ship agent

- 4. If the shipping company assumes payment of cargo handling charges, the client shall remain liable for payment along with the shipping company.
- 5. Storage charges shall be charged to the ordering party. In the case of discharged cargo, the charge is calculated for the whole storage period, even if the cargo is released at a later date.
- 6. If, in the case of goods in transit, the right of disposal changes, the first ordering party shall remain liable for payment of charges, unless he has expressly stipulated in the order that said goods shall only be delivered under the term collect on delivery (COD).
- 7. Charges for any services not specifically mentioned shall be made to the respective ordering party. The acceptance of an order implies that the client has agreed on direct debit in advance.
- 8. Any offset against the Company's accounts receivable is hereby excluded, unless the counterclaim put forward for offset is uncontested or has become res judicata.

2 Vessel charges

Charges are payable by the shipping line or its agent. The provisions contained in Section 1, Paragraph 1.4 shall not be affected thereby.

2.1 Berth Dues/Tonnage dues

Every vessel berthed at the handling facilities must pay tonnage dues. Tonnage dues shall be based on the gross tonnage index (Law of 22 January 1975 on International Convention on Tonnage Measurement of Ships dated April 23, 1969) of the vessel concerned and shall amount to the gross tonnage index multiplied by:

 a) For the first 24 hours or part thereof 	EUR	0.70

b)	for every	additional	12 hours	or part thereo	of EUR	0.50
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The time counts from time of berthing without break to the time of departure. Sundays and high holidays count as days if the ship concerned is working on these days.

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2.2 Lay-by berth

Vessels using the Container Terminal as lay-buy berth before the start of the handling service or after the completion of the handling service, for whatever reason, shall pay a fee of:

per 24 hours or part thereof per TEU EUR 1.20

Berth charge, which is based on the maximum nominal loading capacity measured in TEU (twenty foot equivalent unit).

The berthing time begins at the time of berthing and is charged continuously until the time of casting off. Sundays and public holidays as well as afternoons before high holidays count as berthing time.

2.3 Quay dues

Quay dues shall be applied to goods loaded/discharged via the quay:

- a) Vessel engaged in ocean traffic (outgoing and incoming traffic) **EUR 8,15**/1,000 kg
- b) Vessel engaged in inland-waterway traffic (incoming and outgoing) EUR 4.80/1,000 kg

Quay dues will also apply to cargo which is handled

- from quay to watercraft or from watercraft to quay
- from quay to seagoing vessel, using a floating crane; or from seagoing vessel to quay using floating crane
- from watercraft to a seagoing vessel loading at the pier, using a floating crane; or from a seagoing vessel discharging at the pier to watercraft, using a floating crane
